

Registration of additional persons on the GloPortal system.

Dear Resident

The number and categories of persons that were allowed to register on the GloPortal system was limited to ten (10) persons as per full title stands and six (6) per sectional title staying or working at the stand.

The system excluded the registration of non-residents.

During a Board of Directors meeting held on 11 March 2019 approval was granted that those persons who are non-residents still in possession of a valid click-on access card qualify to be biometrically enrolled if the owner/main member consents to that and the persons information has been added to the GloPortal system

If there is a need for new non-resident family members to be enrolled on the biometric system, the owner must apply on the attached application form and will only be enrolled after approval by the Security Committee and loaded on the GloPortal system.

Please take note that the new Glo Visitor system will also make provision to issue a regular access code to frequent visitors.

The registration of non-resident card holders is subjected to the submission of the same documents, i.e. Identification document, driver license, if necessary and a copy of the existing valid click-on access card.

The registration of new applicants is subjected to the same and will be registered at a cost of R60.00 that will be debited against the owners levy account.

Please take note that the total number of persons to be registered on the new system may not exceed the allocated 10 or 6 persons per stand.
